Dr. Karpouchtsis, born in Thessaloniki (Greece), studied Political Science at Freie Universität Berlin and earned his M.A. in European Politics from the University of Bath (UK). In 2023, he completed his PhD at the Jena Center for Reconciliation Studies, Friedrich Schiller University Jena.

Since 2022, he works at the Department of Political Science at Helmut Schmidt University/University of the Federal Armed Forces Hamburg. He is the director of the Civic Education unit at the Democratic Resilience Center and teaches in the field of International Security Policy and Conflict Research.

His dissertation, *Old Wounds, New Foreign Policy? Germany and Greek Martyr Communities: Between Recognition and Reconciliation*, was published by Springer. In 2024, he received the Fritz and Helga Exner Foundation Dissertation Award from the Southeast Europe Association Germany.
